I was recently struck by a quote from Lady Bird Johnson regarding poverty, hope, and nature that I felt applies to the world we find ourselves in today. Her words reminded me that even in the harshest environments, beauty and resilience can take root - and so can hope. In the face of growing hate and pushback against the LGBTQ+ community, we see this same spirit in every pride flag hung in a small town window, every chosen name spoken with love, and every safe space carved out in a hostile world.

Hope fuels authenticity and the ongoing struggle for equality. When we nurture spaces where people can be fully themselves, we are planting flowers in concrete - symbols of resistance and growth. And where flowers bloom, so does hope. **And where hope lives, change becomes possible.**

So let us be gardeners of that hope - speaking up, showing up, and standing firm for a world where everyone can bloom.
