Lately, I find myself swinging between heartbreak and hope. On the positive side: we have just finished Pride month - a time when we celebrate the colorful spectrum that is humanity! It's a time to reinforce that all people have value and should have equal rights, including the right to receive mental and physical health care, to use the bathroom in peace, to travel without harassment, to pursue an education, and even to serve in the military. But, there are forces actively fighting to counter such equality. There have been Supreme Court decisions in the U.S. and the U.K. that seem to push this dream of "equality for all" out of reach. Bans on transgender healthcare are being allowed to stand. Trans-women are not recognized as women in the U.K. The U.S. government discontinued specialized services for LGBTQ+ young people on the 988 lifeline and is purging references to diversity, equity, and inclusion from its websites. How can we support our LGBTQ+ loved ones in the face of all these setbacks?

Instead of dwelling on the darkness, let's look for the light! Governor Stein vetoed a bill harmful to transgender people. The nonprofit Trevor Project provides a lifeline for LGBTQ+ young people. LGBTQ+ representation is increasing at all levels of government - including the openly transgender U.S. Representative Sarah McBride. A 2024 Gallup report states that over 9% of Americans identify as LGBTQ, and all should be represented! There is actually a groundswell of people who want to help support LGBTQ people - including through organizations like PFLAG. I cherish the friends I've made through PFLAG - they educate me and help me to better support my LGBTQ friends, loved ones, and coworkers. Let's not lose hope when we encounter forces that want to send our society backwards - we have the power to positively impact people's lives if we all pitch in together!
